Welcome February! It's hard to believe how fast this school year is going. We have a lot planned for this short month. We'll begin our month with a unit on **Community Helpers**. We will explore the different types of jobs that make our community special, and list where our mom's and dad's work. February 18th is **Ash Wednesday**. This is the first day of Lent. During Lent we as Christians, are called to renew ourselves and to work extra hard at being the best we can be by doing good works for others, praying and trying to do what is right at home and at school.
